Eligible VADIP beneficiaries

- Eligible beneficiaries include any Veteran enrolled in VA health care and any individual enrolled in VA's Civilian Health and Medical Program (CHAMPVA).
- Enrollment in VADIP is voluntary. Coverage starts the first day of the month after your application is received and accepted.
- There is an initial 12-month commitment and after this period, you can continue your coverage on a month-to-month basis.
- You'll pay your monthly VADIP premiums through electronic funds transfer (EFT), which you must set up when you enroll.
