The voter-approval tax rate is the highest tax rate that the COUNTY OF GILLESPIE may adopt

without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that the COUNTY OF GILLESPIE is proposing to increase property taxes for the 2022 tax year.

A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON September 6, 2022 at 5:20 PM at the County Courthouse, 101 West Main, Fredericksburg, Texas.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, the COUNTY OF GILLESPIE is not required to hold an election at which voters may accept or reject the proposed tax rate.
