You must have a valid Marriage License from the County Clerk's Office of any Texas County. License must be 72 hours old but not more than 90 days old. The 72 hour waiting period can be waived if any of the following conditions apply:

- Applicant is a member of the U.S. Armed Forces on active duty;
- The applicant performs works for the Department of Defense as an employee or under contract;
- Applicant obtains a written waiver; or
- Applicant completes a premarital education course and provides a certificate of completion that indicates completion of not more than 1 year before the marriage license application is filed with the clerk.
