

Gillespie County Tax Assessor Collector's office will reopen for business on Monday, June 01, 2020, with office hours of 9:00 am to 4:00 pm.

We will practice social distancing and customers are asked to wait in line until invited to enter the office. Customers should enter the courthouse through the front door and exit our office through the Adams Street door.

We will stop doing boat/motor title transactions at 3:00 pm and vehicle title transactions at 3:30 pm.

We ask that customers have all documents ready and completed before they enter the office. Also, please have your government issued ID and forms of payment ready. Check the list below to ensure that you are ready to finalize your transaction when you come into the office.

Boat Trailers must be registered in the applicant's county of residence with completed form 130-U Application for Texas Title. Government Issued ID and Form of Payment – Cash, Check and/or Credit/Debit Card.
