


Were the Wright Brothers the first flyers?





JACOB BRODBECK (1821–1910)

- Born in Germany, Arrived in Fredericksburg in 1847
 - Teacher, Surveyor, Commissioner
- First man to fly in an airplane (40 years before the Wright Brothers)
 - Conflicting reports
 - 1865 (3 miles east of Luckenbach)
 - 1868 (San Pedro Park, San Antonio)
 - Airship
 - Powered by coiled springs
 - Featured an enclosed space for the "aeronaut," a water propeller in case of accidental landings on water, a compass, and a barometer.
 - Flight Height reached (12') and traveled 100'
