

## **ACCESS CONSTRUCTION PLAN**



## **CULVERT DETAILS**



## NOTES:

- 1. ALL PARTS OF THE ACCESS MUST BE CONFINED TO THE APPLICANTS PROPERTY BOUNDARY OR ACCESS EASEMENT.
- 2. PIPE CULVERTS MUST BE INSTALLED WITH A MINIMUM OF 12" COVER OR THE MINIMUM COVER REQUIRED BY THE MATERIAL'S SPECIFICATIONS, WHICHEVER IS GREATER.
- 3. ACCESS POINTS WITHOUT CULVERTS SHALL BE CONSTRUCTED TO NOT OBSTRUCT THE FLOW OF WATER AND MAY BE REQUIRED TO BE PAVED OR OTHERWISE STABILIZED, AS DETERMINED BY THE COUNTY ENGINEER.
- 4. ACCESS POINTS WITH A SLOPE EXCEEDING 2% TOWARDS THE PUBLIC ROW MAY BE REQUIRED TO BE PAVED OR OTHERWISE STABILIZED, AS DETERMINED BY THE COUNTY ENGINEER.
- ALGEBRAIC DIFFERENCE IN GRADE SHALL BE 6% MAX FOR COMMERCIAL DRIVEWAYS AND 8% MAX FOR RESIDENTIAL DRIVEWAYS.
